Joy and I came to the States for a couple weeks to spend some time with my dad. He says he feels OK but is tired and has really slowed down a lot. Ninety-four years is a long time! He is ready to be with the Lord, but God must still have something here for him to do. He and I sat down to eat lunch together today and he said, "Maybe our next meal together will be in Heaven!" I was reading the Bible to Him, and he would keep saying how good the Lord has been to him, and how the Lord has blessed him so

Of this love my soul is deeply and fully convinced. Yes, my Lord Jesus is good to me. He does not only say so, but He proved it at the cross, where He saved humanity from spiritual death. Jesus also saved us from physical death by healing our body imperfections. During His earthly ministry, Jesus Christ spent a lot of time in healing the sick and disabled, demonstrating God's compassion for human pain. Knowing this, I develop deeper intimacy in my relationship with Him, and I'm more and more available to let Him use me to serve others wherever I encounter need.

It is such a blessing to be part of the Water For Life

Mobile Clinic Program, a program where we assume that physical healings can illustrate spiritual healing. In the same way that the need for water is an "excuse" for us to bring the Gospel of Christ, we use the physical need of healing to tell people about the healing of souls in Jesus Christ!

In fact, since

August 2013, we have done five clinics in very remote places where people, when they are sick, have to walk hours to reach a health care center that is mostly devoid of medical staff, equipment, and medications.

In each of these mobile clinics, to an average of 400 people, we have offered free consultations and medicines. We have offered pediatric, gynecology, ophthalmology, dentistry and general medicine. Also, we encourage the

beneficiaries to adopt good health-care practices to prevent both contagious and non-contagious diseases.

It is a true blessing to work with a team of Haitian and American doctors and nurses, all volunteers, to provide good quality health care to a population in need. I am very thankful that Christ has chosen me to be part of this great healing ministry. Please pray for our team to be always available to go out to reach sick people for Christ. Pray also for our need for medical drugs and equipment. We will be grateful to receive your support.

The Faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning. What a

consolation to know that! It is with great joy and gratitude I inform you that for fiscal year 2012-2013

Water For Life provided water to 46,400 new people, thanks to 116 new wells we drilled with Troy's team.

This current year 2013-2014, we are so excited because *the older rig* is once again back at work!

Indeed, after 2 years of non-operation,

Daryl, our young mechanic who has been with us since October 2013, has rehabilitated it. The second drilling team has already contributed to supply 700 people with drinking water in the area of Pasbwadòm and Vieux Bourg in the Aquin area. We really need your prayers to keep this older rig running for many more years to come; we are hoping to be able to drill an average of 50 new wells drilled each year with it, which translates into almost 20,000 more people in Haiti finding good water to drink, to grow crops and to keep their bodies clean.

As we have already drilled 84 wells, we hope to reach, by the end of the fiscal year, a total of 160 wells capable of supplying drinking water to more than 56,000 people.

All this work is possible because of the faithful love of Christ and your unconditional support. You may go to our website and find out how you can financially help 80 families to have a better life with one well drilled.

Water IS life! Great miracles can be made in agriculture with the availability of water! As you

may already know, Water For Life had drilled an 800 gpm well in the area near Miragoâne called Deuxième Plaine; the large amount of water found in this well inspired the community association to initiate an agriculture project where the farmers can now produce all year long a wide variety of fruits and vegetables, plantain, okra.... totally organic, no additive or pesticide. I'm so glad with your support we could help improve the quality of life of farmers by offering them the opportunity to increase their income and earn a decent living. Your prayers and support will be greatly appreciated in that specific project, any expertise in this field will be welcome also.

Finally, I would like to give glory to God for

the great work he has realized through the Secours Divin (Divine Help) School of Pasbwadòm, where Water For Life, since 1989, meets the educational needs of many children of this village. ***"To the Glory of God, to the pupils' wellbeing and to the staff's satisfaction"*** is the motto of Secours Divin. Today the school is on the path of success; the students are

having better test scores, and teachers and staff are working in harmony. Plans have been made to host, this coming school year, a 10th grade class (since now we only have pre-kindergarten through 9th). The durability of this institution is a miracle each academic year. We are grateful that the Lord uses Water For Life to participate in the academic and spiritual education of the children in PBO.
