A Touch from God for Malaïka

“The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is proclaimed to the poor.” Luke 7:22b (NIV)

Is this not the essence of our mission on earth as Christians—that of bringing light where there is darkness and joy where fear reigns, in order to guide lost souls to our Lord?

Glory to God that you are walking bravely in the footsteps of our Lord Jesus Christ, for with your prayers and financial support you allowed Malaïka (pictured at right) to receive her first surgical treatment for cataracts.



In Haiti, cataracts are one of the main causes of preventable blindness in children. It is important that children with this problem are diagnosed so they can benefit from surgery and can go to school; appropriate follow-up with optical correction and support will ensure these children the best quality of life possible for them.

Unfortunately, due to the diagnostic delays, and the inability of poor parents to provide follow-up care, the visual prognosis of Haitian children with congenital cataracts remains unfavorable.

“I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in Me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.” John 14:12 (NIV) Thus,

we are commissioned by God to perform great miracles. So, through WFL’s Mobile Clinic Program, you may implement your calling and have a significant impact on children, on their family, the community and the whole country.

Each Water Well is a Gift of Life

Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere and is one of the more densely populated in the world. As you already know, access to drinking water and sanitation in rural Haiti is insufficient, contributing to poor living conditions, disease, and a high mortality.

Kapajil is a small village located in the heights of Arniquet, South Department, Haiti. Until last month, the villagers there had to travel through rocky hills more than six miles to access a drinking water in another village. Water for laundry, cleaning and bathing was drawn from this unprotected spring, shown at right.
